



SA4208 Installation Procedure "Behind-the-Grille" Mount Siren Speaker 2000 Chevy Tahoe or 2000 GMC Yukon 2x4




- Remove the Plastic top cap from the horsecollar by backing out the plastic retaining rivets.
- Install the SA4208 Assembly by inserting the assembly behind the grille on the passenger side.
- Rest the top edge of the support bracket onto the top edge of the horsecollart. See FIGURE 2 and FIGURE 3.




SA4208 ASSEMBLY



- 5) For the 2 top holes in the horsecollar, drill with a Ø.250" drill. For the hole in the angle brace, drill with a Ø.375" drill.
- 6) After the holes have been drilled, reposition the speaker assembly.
 7) Insert the two 5/16-18 x 1 1/2"
- Washer Head Self-Threading bolts, with 5/16" Lock Washers (Hardware provided), into the top 2 holes on the support bracket. See FIGURE 3. Using a socket wrench, start the 2 bolts into the horsecollar, but DO NOT TIGHTEN at this time.

- 8) Install the 5/16-18 x 1" Hex Bolt, with 5/16" Flat washer (Hardware provided), into the drilled hole on the Angle Brace and remaining hole on the support bracket. See FIGURE 3. Install the 5/16" Lock washer and 5/16-18 Nylon Lock-nut.
- Tighten all mounting hardware.
- 10) Continue with the electrical connections for the siren assembly as per the manufacturers instructions for the siren amplifier.
- Re-install the plastic top cap with the plastic retaining rivets.

Hardware Included:

- 2 5/16-18 x 1 1/2" Washer Head Self-Threading Bolts
- 1 5/16-18 x 1" Hex Head Bolt (Grade 8)
- 3 5/16" Lock Washers
- 2 5/16" Flat Washers
- 1 5/16-18 Nylon Lock Nut
